Ranch Camp Shoot & Swim Campout

April 17th – 19th, 2015

- CAMP LOCATION:** St. Sebastian Preserve State Park, 1000 Buffer Preserve Drive, Fellsmere, FL 32948. (321)953-5005 <http://www.floridastateparks.org/stsebastianriver/>
- COST PER PERSON:** \$48.00/person (\$2 for Gas, \$2 for Camping, \$5 for Swim Park, \$17 for food, \$22 Range, Ammo Fees). *Note: This is an unusually high campout cost because of the \$22 ammo /range and swimming fee. The actual ammo/range fee is higher, the Troop is kicking in (thank you Troop)*
- FORM/MONEY DUE BY:** **Monday April 6th** Troop Meeting
- LOADING TIME:** Friday, April 17th 6:00 pm from Faith Fellowship Church (*please do not be late, it leaves the loading work to your fellow scouts*)
- PARENT PICKUP:** Sunday, April 19th, 12:30 pm at Faith Fellowship Church (*we always call 1 hour prior to scheduled parent pickup time to confirm*)
- UNIFORM/CLOTHING:** Full Class-A Uniform for Travel. Scout Swim Shorts/Suit (or scout-like colored swim suit if you don't have one). Class-B for all other times.
- MEALS:** The following meals are included in the cost: Friday cracker barrel (eat before you come), 3 Meals Saturday, Sunday Breakfast, and pre-lunch snack (Sunday lunch is not provided). Patrols are not responsible for Saturday Lunch (we'll be tailgating it at the range as a Troop) Remember, individual snacks are not allowed.
- PROGRAM/THEME:** We will camp at Ranch Camp in the St. Sebastian preserve. Saturday morning we will head to the [Indian River County Range](#), where we'll shoot rifle, and shotgun under the supervision of our own NRA instructor, and other leaders. After having a tailgate lunch, we'll head to the [Indian River Aquatics Center](#) for swimming and fun, then head back to Ranch Camp for dinner. Sunday, we'll have breakfast, as Scouts Own Service, and will head home.
- PACKING:** Use these lists to do your Packing:
- Packing List in your Troop Notebook (can be found the Troop Website under [Scouts->Documents](#))
 - Refer to your Scout Handbook for lists.
 - Note: Get the Word Document from the Troop Website and make/print your own (best move)
- Special Required Gear
- Eye & Ear Protection** – The Troop Has some, but if you have your own, bring it (for shooting)
 - Swim Suit** – We request that you bring something to swim in besides the Scout Shorts you will wear during the campout (keep them dry). This can be another pair of scout shorts (most are swim-worthy), a scout swim suit, or if you can't pick up a swim suit or shorts, you can use a regular bathing suit (not preferred but if you do, keep it to earth-tone scout-like colors please).
 - Beach Towel** – For the Pool
 - Camping Chair** (often forgotten)
 - Scout Book** (for advancements)
 - Sports Equipment** (football, Frisbee, etc. be sure to put in car for Alexander)
 - Religious Book** (for personal devotion time)
 - Totn' Chip & Fireman Chit** – **Don't bring them, you can't do them.**
- STANDING RULES:** Please review these standing Troop Rules:
- **Close Toed Shoes Only** – No open toed anything
 - **No Electronics or Cell Phones** at Campground. Cell Phones by Parent Permission only while traveling in car but follow these rules:
 - No social Media
 - No Texting
 - Videos/YouTube by registered adult leader permission before watching only

- All music/video/games must be appropriate
- Cell Phone Usage Rules will be reviewed on departure.
