- CAMP LOCATION:** Ft. Pierce Inlet State Park. www.floridastateparks.org/park/Fort-Pierce-Inlet.
- PROGRAM/THEME:** We will be enjoying lots of time on the beautiful Ft. Pierce Inlet beach, swimming, snorkeling, and building mammoth Troop sand structures. We will also be exploring an adjacent island by canoe.
- COST PER PERSON:** \$30.00 per person. This is \$20 for 5 Meals and Evening Snacks, \$4 for gas, and \$6 Camping/Fort Fees.
- FORM/MONEY DUE BY:** **Monday, November 7th Troop Meeting**
- DEPARTURE:** Friday, November 20th, at 5:30pm, at Faith Fellowship Church
- ARRIVAL:** Sunday, November 22nd at 2:00 pm. Boys will call parents 1 hour prior to arrival to confirm.
- UNIFORM/CLOTHING:** Class-A on Departure and Class-B for the rest of the time. Bathing suits may be worn while swimming/canoeing but should be BSA, or BSA colors if possible (thank you). All kinds of foot-wear must be closed-toed.
- PACKING:** Refer to your Scout Handbook and/or your personal list for your packing list, or the suggested packing list In Scouts->Documents on the Troop Website: Other ideas & reminders are:
- Water Bottles * – For Hiking and Beach Time
 - Snorkel Gear – If conditions are right, the water will be like the Bahamas, great snorkeling! We will have safety vests.
 - Paperwork - Scout Book (for teaching or signing off), Totn' Chip & Fireman Chit, Bible or devotional
 - Camping Chair (*often forgotten*)
- MEALS:** Eat dinner before you arrive on Friday Night. Meals include evening snacks both nights, 3 Saturday meals, and 2 Sunday meals.
- STANDING RULES:** Please review these standing Troop Rules:
- **Close Toed Footwear Only** – No open toed anything
 - **No Electronics or Cell Phones** at Campground. Cell Phones by Parent Permission only while traveling in car but follow these rules:
 - No social Media
 - No Texting
 - Videos/YouTube by registered adult leader permission before watching only
 - All music/video/games must be appropriate
 - Cell Phone Usage Rules will be reviewed on departure.
 - **Patrol Snacks Only** – Individual Snacks or car snacks are not allowed. Scouts may bring one cliff bar type supplement for emergency, but no snacks. It spoils Patrol meals, discourages team cooking, and attracts critters. If a boy has an issue with the food, see the SPL, the Troop has backup food.
