Ranch Camp Cookoff Campout

- CAMP LOCATION:** We will be camping in the “Ranch Camp” campsite in the [St. Sebastian Preserve State Park](#). Ranger Station located at 1000 Buffer Preserve Drive, Fellsmere, Florida 32948. 321-953-5055.
- PROGRAM/THEME:** We will be camping in this spacious, wooded campsite near the “Tree Frog” campsite we’ve been to on previous campouts. Activities include a 3 meal Patrol Cookoff competition on Saturday, an afternoon visit from Pack 337’s Webelos Den (we’ll take them on a short hike and play kickball with them), evening “Capture the Flag” games, and of course a campfire program.
- ATTENTION GRUBMASTERS** (Shoppers): You will be given \$20 per scout to shop. You are encouraged to spend this full amount on your 3 Saturday competition meals. You need to buy enough to give the judges a good sample of your food (like an extra scout or so). If you want to spend more and pay for it yourself, you are welcome to do that. Especially because the Troop is paying for so much of the campout for you.
- COST PER PERSON:** Only \$20 per person! This will be put towards the 3 competition meals. The remainder of the costs will be covered by the Troop (camping fees, transportation, Troop breakfast and Sunday snacks)
- FORM/MONEY DUE BY:** **Monday, January 20th Troop Meeting**
- PACKING & DEPARTURE:** Friday, January 31st, 5:30pm SHARP at the Scoutpost
- PARENT PICKUP:** Sunday, February 2nd, 12:00pm at the Scoutpost.
- UNIFORM/CLOTHING:** Class-A on Departure. Class-B for the rest of the time.
- PACKING:** See the Scout Personal Packing List on the Troop Website under [Scouts->Documents](#). There is a PDF and a Word document so that you can customize and save it for next campout. Here’s some reminders:
- Paperwork - Scout Book (for teaching or signing off), Totn’ Chip & Fireman Chit, religious book (Bible) or devotional
 - Camping Chair (often forgotten)
 - Special items for the Cooking Competition
- MEALS:** **EAT DINNER BEFORE YOU COME FRIDAY!** Patrols or Troop will supply Friday Cracker Barrel and all 3 meals on Saturday. Troop will supply Sunday Breakfast, and a snack prior to coming home on Sunday (but not lunch).
- STANDING RULES:** *Please review these standing Troop Rules:*
- **Close Toed Shoes Only** – No open toed sandals
 - **No Electronics or Cell Phones** at Campground. Cell Phones by Parent Permission only while traveling in car and are subject to the following rules:

 - All music/video/games must be appropriate
