Does this mean money is bad?

Proverbs 21:20 The wise have wealth and luxury, but fools spend whatever they get

Proverbs 13:22

A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, And the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous.

Does not seem like money is bad if the wise and righteous have it...

Proverbs 16:8

Better is a little with righteousness Than great income with injustice.

So is it about the money or the place money holds?

What does scripture say about money and evil?

1 Timothy 6:10 For the **love of** money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs

Jesus talked more about money than he did Heaven and Hell combined. Eleven of the 39 parables He tells are about finances. **WHY?**

Matthew 6:21 Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be **Again, where is your focus?**

So, back to the code: Knights Code: Despise Monetary Reward is about why we do what we do, if everything is about your gain, you are not serving, if everything you do is about God AND there is gain, how much more can you help others?

Mathew 6:24 “No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.
