

## Troop 337 Scout Packing List

### CAMPING EQUIPMENT

- Camp Chair
- Knife (with Totin' Chit)
- Flashlight (fresh batteries)
- Compass
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- Personal First Aid Kit
- Rope & Twine
- Sleeping Bag/Pillow/Mat or Pad
- Hammock (rope, net, tarp, twine)

### DINING ITEMS

- Mess Kit (with silverware)
- Camp Cup (no water bottles for meals)
- Water Bottles (for day hikes, canoe runs, bike rides, etc)

### PERSONAL EQUIPMENT

- Toiletries
- Towel
- Sports Equipment
- Camera (charged)
- Medication (must turn in to adult leader)
- Glasses or Contacts w/ Extra Case & fluid
- Fishing Gear, Bait, Fishing License (if needed)

### PAPER WORK

- Scout Book
- Whittling Chip & Fireman Chit
- Information Sheet, Camp or Trail Maps, Agenda, and other Information from Event Web Page on Troop Website
- Bible or other religious devotional (a Scout is Reverent)
- Required: Writing utensils and notepad
- Patrol Leaders – Duty Rosters & Menus

### CLOTHING

- Troop Dress Shirt
- Troop T Shirts & Wicking Shirts
- Scout Shorts and/or Scout Pants
- Scout Socks
- Hat and/or sunglasses
- Clothing for the Cold or cool nights
- Rain Gear
- Scout Bathing Suit (otherwise earth-toned swim suit)
- Backup Shoes (in case one gets wet)

### IF CANOEING or BOATING

- Whistle (required for boating)
- Close Toed Water Shoes or Close-Toed sandals (required)
- Dry Bag or Trash Bags (to keep everything dry)

### IF HIKING

- Whistle (required for hiking)
- Hiking Stick
- TP & Wipes
- Duct Tape/Wire/Twine (for repairs)
- Backpack Rain Fly
- Trash Bag (to keep stuff dry)
- Water Bottles (see info sheet for suggestions on amount for the particular hike)

### PLC MEMBERS

- Duty Rosters
- Menus
- Agenda
- Patrol Equipment (see equipment checklist)
- Check Troop Equipment Checklist
- Check Troop Quartermaster Checklist
